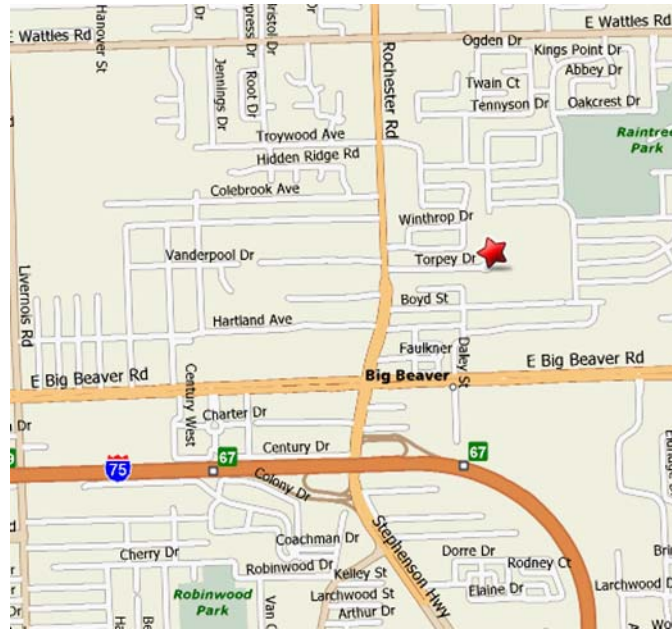

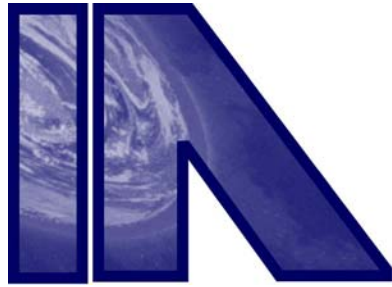

Mandatory Placement and Diagnostic Testing

Attend either time:

Tuesday, March 3rd : 4– 6:30 p.m.

Wednesday, March 4th: 6– 8:30 p.m.

Students whose names were selected in the lottery as well as students on the waiting list should plan to test in March.

Diagnostic and Placement Test -- approximately 2 1/2 hours -- designed to help you make an informed choice and place you in the appropriate level of math. The IA will consider students' academic records and placement test results when making its recommendation for attendance. Completion of Algebra 1 or its equivalent is necessary prior to admission. In March, letters will be sent to those students whose records and results indicate that they do not match the IA's academic mission.

Test Includes:

- Mathematics- demonstration of algebraic skills required
 - Personal essay and reading passage analysis
