School Sponsored Independent Enrichment

Involvement in school sponsored activities can help students develop leadership and collaborative skills, learn time management skills, improve confidence, self-esteem and social skills while providing an overall enriching experience. Due to these important life skills learned as well as the enormous amount of time devoted to these activities, students may now be able to receive enrichment credit for ONE of these activities.

These can include but are not limited to home school athletics, travel sports teams, home school theater productions, forensics teams.

<u>Students must apply for approval at least 30 days in advance of the activity</u>. Application forms are available from our web site (<u>www.iatoday.org</u>) or from the Enrichment office. Some restrictions considered in the approval include:

- · Independent Enrichments may not coincide with normal school hours.
- They must contain at least 20 hours of educational content
- Only three of the required six Enrichments can be Independent.
- Only one of the required six enrichments can be school sponsored
- No clubs will be approved

Once the activity is completed, students will be required present the journals and application signed by the teacher/coach/supervisor to the Enrichment Staff during a private meeting. Credit will be granted subject to the successful completion of all the requirements.
